Cost: Short, inexpensive flights with Easyjet from London Gatwick to Agadir (about £150 return if booked early) plus £535 for: accommodation for 7 nights in twin/double rooms (singles may be possible for a £120 supplement), substantial breakfasts; vegetarian evening meals (option of meat or fish for small supplement. Special diets catered for), 2 excursions, 2 cultural experiences* workshops, “A Feast for the Senses” celebration, and at least 2 hours singing daily. Cost also includes 50-minute road transfer both ways with our own safe drivers to and from Agadir airport.
*choices include trekking, wildlife, crafts, cookery, massage and several other experiences.
